



The U.S.A. has three branches of government: the Executive 💄 Branch, the Legislative Branch, and the Judicial Branch. Each branch holds equal but separate power so that there is a system of checks and balances.

## **Executive Branch**


The Executive Branch is headed by the president and includes the vice-president, and the 15 presidential advisors that make up the Cabinet. The main job of the Executive Branch is to protect and serve the citizens of the United States by enforcing the laws.

# Legislative Branch

The Legislative Branch is headed by Congress. Its job is to create the laws that govern the people. Congress is made up of two parts: the Senate and the House of Representatives. Both the Senate and the House are made up of leaders from every state who have been elected by the people of the states they represent. The Senate has 100 senators: two for every state—no matter how big or small the state. In the House of Representatives, the number of members per state varies according to state population. A state with a large population has more representatives than a state with a small population.

## Judicial Branch

The third branch of government is the Judicial Branch. This branch is responsible for interpreting the laws of the Constitution to make sure everyone is being treated fairly. The Supreme Court of the Judicial Branch is the highest court in the U.S., and everyone—even the president!—must accept its rulings.





Anchorage - a specific place Anchorage is a city in Alaska.


Empire State Building – a specific thing The Empire State Building is in New York City.


